

No. 6 and No. 10 Harbour Lights Thorofare, St. Mary's, Isles of Scilly. TR21 OLN

Arrivals Information

Arrival on St. Mary's by air

- Please ensure that all items of luggage are clearly labelled with your name and holiday address making sure that you specify whether you are staying in No. 6 or No. 10.
- Whether you are travelling by **helicopter** or **aeroplane**, you will land at the heliport on St. Mary's.
- Shuttle buses will be awaiting flight arrivals and there is no need to book ahead. If there is no sign of the shuttles at the time of your arrival, there will be one along shortly!
- You will be able to purchase return tickets for the shuttle from your driver. Please ask him for details of where and when to meet the mini-bus for your return journey to the heliport.
- Simply tell your driver where you are staying and you will be dropped off with your luggage at the top of a narrow pedestrian lane that runs between Tide Lines (gift shop) and Bordeaux (gift shop). Alternatively, they may take you to the door.
- Walk down the lane. Ahead of you will be Harbour Lights, a white three-storey building.

Arrival on St. Mary's by sea

- If you are arriving by **Scillonian**, you will arrive on St. Mary's Quay.
- There is no need to await unloading of your luggage as all clearly labelled St. Mary's luggage will be automatically delivered to your holiday accommodation for a small charge by local haulage firms Island Carriers (01720 422662) or Richard Hand Haulage (01720 423007).
- All luggage must be clearly labelled with name, holiday address and the island to which you are travelling.
- If you prefer to collect your luggage in person at St. Mary's Quay, please indicate this on your luggage labels, or refrain from indicating your island accommodation.
- During the course of your stay, please contact the carrier to make payment for the delivery and to make any necessary arrangements for collection of your luggage for delivery to the quay on your return journey.
- To find Harbour Lights:
 - Walk along the quay, bearing right at the end of the main quay so that The Mermaid pub is on your left.
 - Turn left at The Mermaid walking straight ahead, passing the chemist on your right.

- Continue ahead past The Atlantic Hotel on your left. Lloyds Bank and The Kavorna will be on your right.
- Walk past the Co-op and Barclays Bank on your left.
- The Bishop and Wolf pub will be ahead on your right.
- Opposite the Bishop and Wolf pub you will see Tide Lines gift shop on your left.
- To the right of Tide Lines is a pedestrian lane that leads down to Harbour Lights. Turn down that lane. If you get as far as the Bordeaux shop you will have gone too far.
- Harbour Lights is the white three-storey building immediately in front of you.

Arrival at Harbour Lights

- Harbour Lights is an old building. Please take great care to ensure your own safety and the safety of those for whom you are responsible.
- Please be aware that steps within the building may not be uniform or a little steep in places and that the floor in the entrance hall to Harbour Lights, in the area of the washing machines, slopes downwards towards the courtyard at the rear.
- Please take particular care to mind your head on entering the building from Thorofare (the lintel is a little low) and in negotiating the step as you come through the front door.
- No. 6 can be found by walking through the hall of Harbour Lights, through a fire door and along to the end of the hallway where you will find a further door leading out into the courtyard. Do not go up the spiral staircase but go through the door into the courtyard.. The door to No.6 is immediately on your right as you step through the courtyard doorway. It is a white front door with obscured glazing.
- No. 10 can be found by walking through the hall of Harbour Lights, through the fire door and along to the end of the hallway where you will find a spiral staircase. Go up the stairs to the first floor. You will find the door to No. 10 along a short inner hallway to your left.

Keys and arrival times

- Your apartment will be ready for you at 1pm when the hire period commences.
- You will find the keys to the apartment awaiting your arrival in the front door.
- If you arrive earlier, you may meet our housekeeper, Traci Badcock, working within the apartment. She will let you know if your flat will be ready earlier than 1pm.
- You may leave your luggage under the spiral staircase until you can get into the apartment but you will do so entirely at your own risk.
- Neither the owners, the agent nor the Management Company of Harbour Lights can accept any responsibility for any loss or damage to your luggage in any way. Please ensure that any left luggage is tucked out of the way and is not left obscuring walkways in order to minimise the risk of damage to your luggage and injury to others.
